

Carolina Cross Connection 2024 Honduras: Awareness Experience Registration Agreement



YOUTH. CCC Honduras participants must have completed the 8th grade before coming to camp or be accompanied by a legal guardian. We encourage you to bring a variety of people, as bringing a good balance of ages, genders, and experience helps us achieve the balances we seek in our camp community. Groups of any size are welcome, but please call if looking to bring 30 people or more. By registering, your group covenants with CCC that you will make any final changes to the group's numbers by the date given to you by the Honduras Administrator (Juanfer Rodriguez). You will receive information on how to input and update your roster to note any such changes. Your church will be "locked-in" to the number of persons for whom you have registered as of the date given, and you are responsible to pay the appropriate fees for each space reserved from then on.

CURIOS SPACE. Carolina Cross Connection strives to uphold a curious space for all students and adults. Curious Spaces means we hope that all participants will come curious and ready to learn about people who may be different than themselves in some way. **Throughout our work, we support diversity across all lines of difference, including age, economic circumstance, ethnicity, sex, race, range of ability, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity/expression, doctrines or political beliefs.** As an organization, we are deeply committed to the Word of God as revealed to us in Jesus and the words of Scripture, and like Jesus we invite all people to The Table. As a community, we strive to be a place that honors biblical discernment and the freedom to disagree on matters. We aim to lead by example, viewing and encouraging diversity as a fundamental and abiding strength of the church and therefore CCC. ADULT REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL CAMPS. CCC takes the safety and spiritual development of our youth and adults in camp very seriously. As a group leader, we are counting on you and your church to also take these seriously and ask that you carefully recruit and prepare the adults coming to all CCC programs. There is no limit to the number of adults you can bring. **All adults should be:**

- *Willing and able to participate in all activities**
- *Stay the entire week**
- *Be suitable to work with youth & be a role model**
- *Have a National Criminal and Sex Offender Background Check done by May 15, 2024**

REGISTRATION. Registration should be reviewed and completed by the entire group to encourage total group understanding for the commitments being made. We strongly encourage you to make accurate estimates and obtain non-refundable deposits from your participants as you make payments to CCC. CCC will keep all deposits no matter the circumstance. In the cases of a pandemic, natural disaster, or CCC feels Honduras is too unsafe to bring groups in, deposits are non-refundable but the rest of the payments will be returned. Once registration is received, we will send you a confirmation e-mail, notifying you of your camp week assignment (please list your group's top three week preferences on the registration form). You will receive other correspondence through the year, including payment reminders and preparation materials. If you are registering after March 1, 2024, please contact the CCC office first, as space may be limited.

FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVE. Space is limited and filled on a first-come, first-served basis, therefore we urge you to register as soon as possible. It is to your advantage to complete and submit registrations/deposits early to help ensure your group gets to participate and to increase the chance of receiving your first preference of weeks. If your registration is not accepted for any reason, your deposit will be returned to you. If your registration is accepted, then your deposit and all following payments are considered NON-REFUNDABLE and non-transferable.

MEETINGS. Before signing up each group is required to have an introduction meeting. After signing up, our Honduras Admin will schedule 3-4 team meetings throughout the year.

AIRFARE. After your information meeting with our Honduras Administrator and we receive your first deposit, CCC will reserve your plane tickets from the airport of your choice. CCC reserves the right to add to your price if the airfare is over \$900 per participant.

CHANGES OR CANCELLATIONS. Groups of any size are welcome, but please call if looking to bring 30 people or more. By registering, your group covenants with CCC that you will make any final changes to the group's numbers by date given to see you by the administrator. You are responsible to pay the appropriate fees for each space reserved from then on.

CCC prefers that your group does not decrease in number after the initial deposit. If members do drop out before date given by the Honduras Admin their deposit will be forfeited. Dropping any number after date given by administration will result in you having to pay the full balance due for the spots you drop. Adding members to your group after initial registration may be possible but should never be assumed. Please call first, and bear in mind that we cannot exceed our camp capacities. Any group canceling after date given by administration is still responsible for paying the balance due for half the number of persons who were registered to come with their group as of date given by administration. Group cancellations must be submitted in writing.

Numbers are automatically locked in for any participants registering after December 15, 2023, and groups must pay the total balance for the number of people who registered, no matter what the final, actual numbers may be. All deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable, even in the event of a natural disaster or pandemic. If your group's second payment is not received by December 15, 2023, CCC reserves the right to cancel your airfare. This protects CCC from holding camp spaces that will not be paid for and used. If at any point you realize your payment will be delayed, please contact the CCC office immediately so we do not decrease group size.
