

Group Make-Up

Background Checks

Participants 25 & older must submit a CCC Adult Screening Form to verify a background check has been completed within the last three years.

Finalized Numbers

Since your group size will be finalized in March, please make sure your group make-up is as accurate as possible, even in your initial registration. Ages/genders/drivers, etc. matter a great deal when we are doing camp assignments. If you need assistance in editing your existing group make-up, please contact the CCC office.

Adult/Student Ratio

CCC requires one DRIVING (over the age of 25) adult for every 5 students and non-driving adults in your group. CCC asks that you have at least one adult of each gender if your group is co-ed. In the event that this isn't attainable for your group, please note the Group Leader (regardless of their gender) will be the main point of contact in camp should any emergency, behavioral, or personal issues arise with students. If your group is co-ed and there are male and female adults present, CCC staff will take the appropriate measures to talk to adults of the same gender as students needing assistance.

Driving & Non-Driving Adults

Driving Adults must be 25 or older. Driving adults are responsible for driving their work teams to their worksite every day. If group size allows, CCC will make every effort to put two adults, one of each gender, in each group. Please know that this is not guaranteed, and group size does not always allow for this. These numbers are necessary to ensure a safe, positive and impactful experience for campers and the folks we serve. Not having enough driving adults and proper vehicles results in lessening the number of families served and CCC's overall impact in the community.

Non-Driving Adults are adults 25 & older that can act as a second adult in a work team.

Vehicles

Vehicles will be used during the week to transport work teams to and from worksites. For Service Weeks, your group must commit to bring one suitable vehicle for every 6 total members of your group (number should be equal to the number of Driving Adults). Vehicles must be capable of hauling at least 6 people (with seat belts) and tools/lunch coolers each day. CCC cannot provide vehicles for groups. Your group is responsible for all vehicle expenses at CCC, including gas. Drivers are welcome to haul trailers for carrying tools, at their own risk.
